Footnotes

GREY MEMO unhurried early, moved up outside a rival on the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to prove best. HUGH HEFNER dueled three deep, inched away leaving the second turn, angled in on a clear advantage but was overtaken in deep stretch. CEEBAND saved ground off the pace, moved up on the second turn, angled around a rival nearing the stretch, then rallied on the rail for third. QUEENIE BELLE wide early, stalked the dueling leaders outside, bid three deep into the second turn, then angled in and weakened. COLONIAL WARRIOR saved ground off the early pace, came out and split rivals with a move forward on the second turn, went three deep into the stretch and just missed third. HIGH HONOR squeezed at the start, angled in between horses into the first turn when unhurried, went four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and improved position. DR CARSON saved ground early, came out on the backstretch, bid three deep on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. COZY MAN saved ground in midpack early, went outside a rival on the second turn and did not rally. IT'S ALL INSTINCT settled outside chasing the pace and lacked a late response. WOLFWITHINTEGRITY angled in nearing the first turn, dueled inside to the second turn, then dropped back on that bend and weakened. MISCONCEPTION angled in and vied for command between horses, dropped back leaving the backstretch and had little left. I'M GUNNA GO steadied at

the start, trailed off the rail, angled in on the second turn and failed to menace.
