DREAM DAY saved ground stalking the pace, inched up on the second turn, awaited room leaving that bend, swung out into the stretch, rallied to the front three deep a sixteenth out and pulled clear under steady handling. FORTY PUREZA (ARG) three deep into the first turn, stalked outside the winner, bid three wide into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, lugged inward in the final furlong but held second. KATE'N AMY had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and in the stretch, was no match for the winner and was edged for the place. PAPIER MACHE had speed outside a rival and dueled alongside that one to the stretch, then weakened. MUSCHI unhurried outside a rival early, moved up a bit off the rail on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. PASSIONATE CAPER angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. IMGUNABEINPICTURES pulled some and chased a bit off the rail early, came out on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn, gave way and was eased late.
