EXUMA unhurried from the inside, came out on the second turn, awaited room approaching the stretch, swung out leaving the final bend, rallied and collared leader under left hand urging and edged away. DAKOTA PHONE was off a step slow, reserved while outside foe, shifted out around second turn, caught five wide into the stretch and outside winner and was along late for second. MATTY'S G FORCE settled on two wide path and outside rival to second turn, rushed up three wide on the final turn, challenged and gained lead, padded that margin in upper stretch but was collared and lost placing late. CAMBRIDGE BLUE reserved outside winner to second turn, came our further leaving that bend and lacked needed late punch. HOLY HUMOR pulled his way to the front then stepped well clear in the middle stages, remained inside, was overhauled into the stretch and weakened. SINCITY GLOW led second flight to final turn from the inside, continued along the rail and failed to threaten. GO ALL IN reserved inside, remained along the fence throughout and was outrun.
