Footnotes

STORMY LINDA sped to the early lead on the inside, maintained the advantage around the turn, inched away from her rivals under some urging in midstretch, had the rider lose his whip leaving the sixteenth marker but was clear at the wire. LED ADVANTAGE was in a comfortable stalking position slightly off the rail down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, remained on the wood through the stretch drive and gained the place while no real threat to the winner. KISS MY SWISS stalked the winner on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, came into the stretch three wide and was outfinished for the place in the late stages. BALLERINA ANGEL stalked the pace outside the winner down the backstretch, came into the lane between horses and weakened between foes in the final furlong. MAGICROOY chased on the inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, swung out in the lane and finished between horses while lacking the necessary rally. VERY VINTAGE chased outside a rival around the turn and failed to mount a bid in the final furlong. MORNING FROST chased from the back of the pack down the backstretch, was asked for run at the quarter pole and made no impact in the lane.
