PEND OREILLE had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away in midstretch and won clear under some urging. SMOKING G dueled outside the winner to the stretch, was not a match for that one in the final furlong but clearly second best. SHERIFF HUTTON chased between horses then off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. UNCOMMON SENSE sent along outside early, stalked off the rail, angled in some on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. WISE GUISE angled in and chased inside, came out in the stretch and did not rally. JEFFERY'S PRIDE chased between horses then was shuffled back some into the turn, continued off the rail and was not a threat. SUPER CANDY wide early, was sent along four wide on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked a response in the stretch. LUCKY AND TOUGH between horses early, dropped back and angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and failed to menace. ES LUNA broke a bit slowly, dropped well back along the inside in the early going, was always outrun, came out into the stretch and was eased through the drive.
