Footnotes

BUDROYALE stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside KLINSMAN on the second turn, gained command leaving that bend and drew clear under a strong hand ride. MOORE'S FLAT, settled between horses, continued off the rail, angled in for the second turn, came out nearing midstretch and just got second. WILD WONDER stalked the pace off the rail, went outside the winner on the backstretch, bid three deep approaching the second turn, was no match for the winner in the lane and just lost the place. EVENT OF THE YEAR, bobbled slightly at the start, angled in and saved ground on the first turn, drifted out some leaving the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a response. KLINSMAN (IRE) sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. RIVER KEEN (IRE) four wide into the first turn, continued outside MOORE'S FLAT, angled in a bit for the second turn and did not rally.
