### Footnotes

SILVER WAND stalked the pace three deep then between horses into and on the second turn, found the inside in upper stretch, came out under left handed urging past midstretch and wore down the runner-up late. HEAVENLY LILLY took the early lead, set the pace inside then a bit off the rail, inched away on the second turn and held on well but was caught late. ON LONDON TIME four wide into the first turn, settled off the rail, went up four wide into and on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. SINGLE MARKET off a bit slowly, settled inside, went between horses into the second turn, came in on a foe and steadied midway on that bend, came out in upper stretch and had a mild late bid. UKATABEKIDDING stalked the pace a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the second turn and lacked the needed response. LADY LE QUESNE (IRE) pulled her way between horses and steadied leaving the first turn, moved up inside leaving the backstretch, took up in tight along the rail and clipped heels on the second turn and dropped back, then was not persevered with in the stretch. Following a stewards' inquiry, SINGLE MARKET was disqualified and placed sixth for interference on the second turn.
