SHORT ROUTE forced the pace three deep on the backstretch, stalked off the rail on the turn, re-bid outside the runner-up past midstretch and gamely prevailed under urging. INSPIRING went up inside rivals but a bit off the rail to duel for the lead, inched away and angled in entering the turn, came a bit off the fence again into the stretch, fought back inside the winner through the final furlong and just failed to hold off that one. OFF THE RICHTER bobbled at the start, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn then swung four wide into the stretch, lugged inward through the drive but narrowly edged a rival for third. ISLAND ESCAPE saved ground stalking the pace, came out around a rival in midstretch and was edged for third inside. PEGASUS ROSE stalked the pace off the rail, angled in for the turn and lacked the needed response in the stretch. CONVEYOR'S ANGEL off a bit slowly, settled out from the inside chasing the pace, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. DONNA'S DOLL duelled between horses on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, dropped back leaving the bend, angled inward in the stretch and weakened. GOOD LORD LAURIE chased off the inside then outside on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
