Footnotes

BLACK SEVENTEEN sent along inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the turn and drew off in the stretch under urging. TEMECULA CREEK dropped back off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, moved up inside leaving the turn, came out nearing midstretch and gained the place late outside foes. STREET LIGHTS dueled between horses then stalked a bit off the rail and just held third between foes late. SOMETHING SONIC five wide early, chased off the rail, or outside, came into the stretch alongside a rival and just missed the show. SAINTLY SON four wide early, stalked off the rail then inside for the turn and stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SUNSHINE RIDGE chased outside then alongside a rival, dropped back on the turn and weakened. HOT FLAME prompted the pace between foes then three deep, also dropped back on the turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
