Footnotes

TOPPER SHOPPER dueled briefly then set pressured pace along the rail disposed of pursuer in upper stretch and powered away under strong hand urging and one crack of whip left handed. DONEITAGAIN settled outside, shifted in approaching the turn, found the fence, continued inside and bested others. SKYSPY stalked off the rail then outside runner-up on the turn, was three wide entering the stretch, four wide through the lane and held the show. PROFESSNL COURTESY reserved inside, chased along the rail to the stretch and narrowly missed third. TRACTON'S GOLDEN chased outside rival and two wide to the stretch, came in some in midstretch, lacked room along the rail and failed to threaten. MILWAUKEEBREWKAROO lagged far back to the turn, angled out entering the stretch, then lugged out late and was never a factor. WHATEVER WHENEVER forced the pace outside winner, remained prominent and on two wide path into the lane but had little left.
