Footnotes

SELF MADE MAN stalked outside, bid three deep on the second turn, battled outside the runner-up into and through the stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. FIERY TRIPPI pulled early and dueled a bit off the rail then stalked inside, bid between horses on the second turn, took a short lead, fought the rail into the stretch, fought back along the fence through the final furlong and continued willingly. ZAPPA chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. SKIPPY DUE settled off the pace inside, went outside a rival on the second turn, angled back to the inside in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. JAMES PRIOR stalked a bit off the rail then inside, bid from the fence midway on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. ONE SHOT (ARG) dueled outside a rival, inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back midway on the second turn, fell back nearing the stretch and also weakened. JOE CARL chased three deep then outside, went three wide into the stretch and did not rally. HE'S REALLY BIG chased between horses then a bit off the rail, dropped back some on the second turn, lacked a further response, did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off.
