Footnotes

MIS UPSTART, prompted the pace three deep to the stretch, took command in upper stretch, drifted in when clear and drew off under a steady hand ride. PUDDY CAT, four wide into the first turn, continued close up outside, was three deep leaving the second turn and gained the place late. SHIFTY HUSSEY forced the pace outside MONEY IN THE SHEET, battled between rivals into and on the second turn, was no match for the winner and lost second late. MONEY IN THE SHEET, had speed inside early, dueled inside SHIFTY HUSSEY to the stretch and weakened. COOKIN VICKIE, bumped at the start, was close up while saving ground to the stretch and also weakened. BRIDE, settled off the inside, made a mild move forward inside LAC TAHOE on the second turn, came out for the stretch and lacked the needed rally. LAC TAHOE, bumped at the start, raced in a good position outside COOKIN VICKIE, dropped back nearing the second turn and gave way.
