FAIR BIANCA stalked or forced the pace along the inside, bid on the rail on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away, drifted out despite right handed urging past the eighth pole and pulled clear. BRAIDS AND BEADS sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail or between horses, fought back into the stretch, steadied behind the winner just past the eighth pole and held second. SOPHISTICATEDBLUFF bobbled a the start, went up between horses early then stalked outside a rival, bid outside on the backstretch and second turn and three deep into the stretch and just held third. BARE NECESSITIES saved ground early, split horses on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail on the second turn, angled in for the stretch, came out a bit and just missed the show. GINGER ROO four wide into the first turn, chased between horses then off the rail, angled in some on the second turn and weakened. EXZACTA MAX unhurried a bit wide early, settled outside a rival then off the rail, continued outside a foe into the stretch and did not rally. BELIEVE IN MAGIC five wide into the first turn, chased three deep on the backstretch, angled to the inside on the second turn and weakened. RIDE TO VICTORY pulled and was in a bit tight early, angled in and saved ground but was outrun. The stewards' conducted an inquiry into the stretch run between the top pair but made no change when they ruled the trouble to BRAIDS AND BEADS did not cost that runner a placing.
