Footnotes

CAME ABOARD chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to get up late as the rider lost the whip nearing the wire. SIETE MACHOS pulled his way along to stalk the pace three deep, bid three wide on the second turn, took the lead in the stretch, inched away in midstretch, drifted out and held on well but was caught late. WARREN'S KONG stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, split horses past midstretch and picked up the show. CALIFORNIA COLONEL close up stalking the pace inside then a bit off the rail, bid between foes on the second turn, had the rider lose the whip a quarter mile out, continued between rivals until nearing midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. FIRE IN THE WIND had speed outside a rival then inched away and set the pace a bit off the rail, angled in the second turn, fought back leaving that turn and until midstretch and also weakened. KEY TO THE CITY a bit slow to begin, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response.
