**Footnotes**

HIGH BOLLY squeezed a bit at the start, went between foes early, chased the runaway leader along the inside, remained on the rail and rallied to the lead under urging a sixteenth out, then pulled clear. MUST BE IRISH quickly sped clear, opened a huge lead on the backstretch, remained well clear on the turn and into the stretch then shortened stride in the final furlong but held second. GRITTY MADAM chased between horses on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn and saved the show. DENA'S DIAMOND a bit crowded at the start, was sent between foes early then angled in nearing the turn, came out leaving the bend and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ALYDA KALYDA settled between foes early then off the rail, continued three deep on the turn and did not menace. WOODFORD PRINCESS settled off the rail on the backstretch, went between foes a half mile out, angled in for the turn and lacked a rally. NO EQUITY angled in and chased the leader three deep on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn and weakened. COLLEENS RACER settled in midpack between foes early and outside on the backstretch and failed to menace. SALOON SINGER wide early, settled outside on the backstretch, angled to the rail leaving the turn and was never a threat. PREDICTABLEMARY saved ground unhurried to the stretch and failed to respond. PALA CIELO hopped in a bit of a slow start, pulled her way between horses and steadied on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the turn and was not a factor.
