Footnotes

IMVERYPRIVATE sent along inside to duel for the lead, inched away a bit off the rail on the turn and held on gamely under urging. SHEZA GLADIATOR had good early speed off the rail then dueled outside the winner, stalked that one off the rail then outside a rival on the turn and was clearly second best. EXCESS ROUGE off a bit awkwardly, pulled her way between horses to chase the leaders, bumped with a rival leaving the turn and just got the show. GABBY DANCER lagged back off the rail without early speed, came out some in the stretch and put in a late bid at third. ICEE CHEASPEAKE broke slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace on the backstretch and turn and lacked the needed late response but lost the show late. SANDY SNEAKERS chased between horses then four wide leaving the backstretch and into the turn, bumped with a rival leaving the bend and weakened. THERMOSTATIC was in a good position chasing the leaders between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, was shuffled back nearing midway on the bend, angled in and also weakened. STICKY NOTE went up outside on the backstretch to track the leaders, continued five wide into the turn and four wide into the stretch and gave way.
