CANONIZE stalked the pace off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, took the lead three wide past the eighth pole and pulled clear under some urging. CANDY LION chased off the inside, angled out into the stretch, drifted in some and was second best. MR. MONKEY JONES chased three deep then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. LT. HOPEFUL stalked the pace just off the rail, bid alongside a rival leaving the turn, took a short lead between horses in the stretch and lost third late. CAPTAIN STEEL bobbled at the start and dropped back off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was not a threat. EL SCORPIO settled outside chasing the pace, angled to the inside on the turn and lacked the needed rally. TITRANIUM chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. Z DAY sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back leaving the turn and to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong.
