KRISSY C. chased between horses then outside, moved up four wide on the turn, gained the lead into the stretch, kicked clear and held under urging. SWISS PLEASE stalked the pace off the rail, split foes three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and continued willingly. MEMO LADY threw her head at the start and was a bit crowded early, chased inside, moved up along the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and edged a rival for third. HEIRLOOM ROSE off a bit slowly,.settled just off the rail then inside on the turn, came out in upper stretch and just missed the show. LATIN HEART stalked inside, split horses leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MISS WHIM Z chased between horses then off the rail, angled in some on the turn and lacked a rally. ATA GULCH chased outside on the backstretch and four wide on the turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary

response. LEGALLY WILD allowed to settle just off the inside chasing the pace and did not rally. REAL SPITFIRE in a bit tight early, settled off the rail, went four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. IMPERIAL TOWER chased between horses on the backstretch, split rivals then angled in some on the turn and weakened. HALO MS. LION stalked between foes then outside, dropped back on the turn and gave way. SIPHON FUNDS was sent between horses to chase the pace, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and failed to menace. DEVIL'S MAJESTY sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then inside, dropped back past the quarter pole and gave way.
