FUN LOGIC chased between rivals then inside, came out nearing midstretch, gained the lead under left handed urging past midstretch and pulled clear. LAKE MARINA sped to the early lead, angled in and dueled inside, regained the advantage and inched away on the second turn, could not hold off the winner but bested the others. SWEET TRAVEL (IRE) bobbed at the start, chased three deep then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and picked up the show. SWEET WAY stumbled at the start, settled off the rail then inside, continued along the fence in the stretch and was not a threat. SILENT FUSAICHI three deep into the first turn, dueled outside a rival, put a head in front three deep on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn, angled in some and weakened. GOTTA HAVE HER bobbed and broke a bit inward, stalked inside then bid between foes on the backstretch and into the second turn, fell back leaving that turn and also weakened. VEELA settled inside then a bit off the rail, was outside ar rival into the second turn and lacked a further response.
