Footnotes

RAINGEAR chased between horses then outside a rival, ranged up three deep on the turn to gain the advantage a quarter mile out and won clear under a crack of the whip and steady handling. TRIBAL JUSTICE chased inside then a bit off the rail, split horses on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and edged a rival late for second. SEVEN POINT ONE bobbled a bit at the start, stalked just off the inside, waited off heels briefly midway on the turn, went between rivals in midstretch and was edged late for the place. LEMON broke a bit slowly, settled outside a rival or off the rail, came out some in the stretch and bested the others. ARMY OFFICER had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. EARLFROMOKLAHOMA chased outside then alongside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BETTIN AN SWEATIN had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, battled between foes leaving the turn and weakened in the lane. WILD HUNTSMAN broke inward and slowly, saved ground off the pace, was done early and was eased in the stretch.
