Footnotes

AL GHAZI pulled early, stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn, split horses into the stretch, gained a short lead past midstretch and gamely prevailed. PRIZED GEM saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside, reached even terms with the winner in deep stretch and lost the bob. SERVE THE FLAG squeezed a bit at the start, went between horses on the first turn, moved up outside a rival, angled out into the stretch and rallied gamely. STRIKING STORM three deep between foes early, steadied into the backstretch, angled in approaching the second turn, then rallied between horses in the stretch. MODEST MAN angled in and dueled three deep on the first turn and into the backstretch, battled outside a foe on the backstretch and second turn, took a short lead in the stretch but weakened late. KILLER KANE off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position. REAL GRANDE in a good position chasing the pace four wide, dropped back into the second turn and lacked the needed rally. DOC GUS chased between horses early, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. NASHVILLE CAT dueled between horses on the first turn, stalked outside a rival on the backstretch, re-bid three deep on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. SAINTLY ACT settled four wide early then five wide on the backstretch, angled in and dropped back on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and failed to menace. THRILLION had good early speed and dueled inside to the stretch, then dropped back and had little left. CRYSTAL'S

REGAL off a bit slowly, was always outrun, dropped far back and was eased in the stretch.
