TEMPLE'S DOOR tugged his way along to stalk the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the backstretch, bid alongside the runner-up on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away under urging, drifted out from the whip in the final furlong but held sway. PORFIDO (CHI) sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held the place. VICTORIAN PRINCE (IRE) settled outside a rival chasing the pace, moved up some off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and just missed second. FOOLISH COMMENT broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked the needed rally. BALBOA BAY close up stalking the pace off the rail then between foes, continued a bit off the fence on the second turn and weakened. DUCANE stalked outside then three deep, dropped back into and on the second turn and also weakened.
