TENGA CAT dueled outside a rival, took a short lead into the stretch, inched away in deep stretch and won clear under urging. FIVE STAR WILDCAT three deep early, stalked off the rail then inside, came out in midstretch and edged a rival late for second. CALIFORNIA FLAG angled in and dueled inside, fought back past midstretch, lost the place late but held third. TENACIOUS STAR chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. LEMON a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival then angled in, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed response. GENUINELY NOBLE broke slowly and steadied, saved ground off the pace and was not a factor. SILVER WIND steadied inside in the chute, chased a bit off the rail and gave way in the stretch. J. WILLIE broke a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace and was outrun.
