Footnotes

SWISS EXPLOIT stalked four wide then three deep, continued off the rail leaving the turn and a bit wide into the stretch, rallied under urging through the final furlong to get up four wide late. DANDY DANCER had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away a bit off the rail in deep stretch and held on well but was caught late. ACTION CALL sent along to duel three deep, was fanned out into the stretch, battled back in midstretch and continued willingly between foes on the line. EL RANCHO dueled between horses, drifted out some into the stretch, fought back between rivals through the drive and weakened some late. WARREN'S ANDREW chased between horses then off the rail, angled in on the turn and could not summon the necessary response. FERRELIA chased between foes then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. FIRE AQUA pulled his way along then dropped back off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, lugged out on the turn and was outrun.
