THEY CALL HIM EL saved ground around the first turn, stalked the dueling pacesetters on the inside down the backstretch, remained inside a rival around the second turn, waited off heels then swung out at the top of the stretch, bid four wide in midstretch and drew away in the final sixteenth. THE HUNT IS ON stalked outside the winner around the first turn, bid three deep between foes down the backstretch, around the second turn and into the stretch, battled his two inside rivals the length of the stretch and had to settle for second best. LEWDAGW N PARADISE veered in and was bumped at the start, forced or set the pace between horses down the backstretch and around the second turn, battled through the lane between foes and was outfinished for the place at the wire. B'S LUCKY STRIKE sped to the lead into the first turn, set or forced the pace on the inside, was no match for the winner in the final sixteenth but went willingly to the wire inside a three horse spread. VULCAN was bumped between horses at the start, chased off the rail to the lane and did not mount a rally. TRUENO was bumped at the start and squeezed back, taken in hand while rank into the first turn, moved up four wide on the backstretch to press the pace, remained four wide around the second turn and into the stretch, gave way at the top of the lane and was eased in the final yards.
