Footnotes

CHEROKEE HEAVEN three deep early, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came out in the stretch, split horses in midstretch, rallied under some left handed urging and got up four wide late. HE'S A DANCE STAR had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. QUIETLY MINE chased outside a rival then inside, came out in upper stretch, angled back in off heels in midstretch, squeezed through between foes in deep stretch and edged a rival for the show. MARK THE BENCH stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and was outfinished. STERLING OUTLOOK angled in and dueled outside a rival, fought back on the turn and in the stretch, also was between horses in late stretch and was outfinished. OUR SHORTY hopped in a slow start, pulled between horses then three deep early, stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and lacked the needed response in the stretch. POSITION A chased inside then outside a rival leaving the backstretch and on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick.
