Footnotes

HOLLYWOOD STORY settled just off the rail then clipped heels into the first turn, settled again out from the inside, moved up outside leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under some urging to gain the lead in deep stretch, then pulled clear. SIPHON HONEY had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, inched away in the stretch, could not hold off the winner but saved the place. HOUSE OF FORTUNE broke slowly, went up three deep to force the pace to the stretch and held third. MUIR BEACH stalked the pace inside, inched forward on the second turn but lacked the needed response in the final furlong. FENCELINENEIGHBOR stalked early, bid between foes leaving the first turn, dueled between rivals to the stretch and weakened. CISSY (ARG) steadied in tight off heels and came out into the first turn, angled back in and settled off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. QUERO QUERO was in a good position three deep into the first turn then stalked outside a rival, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened.
