KEVLAR KID stalked a bit off the rail, split horses early on the backstretch, bid inside, dueled for command, inched away into the stretch, kicked clear under urging and held sway. ERBEIA broke a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the second turn and into the stretch, came off the rail late and closed the gap to the winner. TIZ A KNIGHT had speed inside to duel for the lead, stalked along the rail on the backstretch and into the second turn, came a bit off the fence leaving that turn and bested the rest. HOLLYWOOD HEIST settled off the rail then between foes on the backstretch, continued just off the fence leaving the second turn and did not rally. SPRING FORTH unhurried outside into the first turn, chased three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ONE NATION angled in nearing the first turn, chased just off the fence then outside a rival on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. COO CACHOO went up outside a rival to duel on the first turn, vied alongside the winner on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the stretch.
