Footnotes

POHAVE stalked the pace inside on the backstretch, went between foes into the turn, bid between horses leaving the bend, gained a short lead nearing midstretch and gamely inched away under urging. MARINO MARINI broke out a bit, tracked the pace outside on the backstretch, bid three deep on the turn and into the stretch, battled outside the winner past midstretch but could not quite match that one late. SUMMER SERVICE sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside a rival then inched away and angled in a half mile out, fought back inside on the turn in the stretch, weakened late and just held third. HASTY KRIS chased a bit off the rail then along the inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and just missed the show. CAYOKE (FR) bobbled at the start, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and also was edged for third. HOMBRE RAPIDO sent along inside to press the early pace, came a bit off the rail and stalked into and on the turn and weakened. T S ELIOT had speed between horses then stalked on the backstretch, dropped back outside a half mile out, angled in leaving the turn and lacked the needed response. KEWEN fell back off the rail soon after the start, settled off the pace, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. SEATTLE SHAMUS stalked between foes then off the rail, dropped back on the turn and weakened.
