INDIANSKI chased outside or off the rail, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied while drifting in under urging to get up on the wire. SMOKENOMORE dueled between horses then inside into the turn, kicked clear on the bend, remained clear past midstretch and was caught on the line. CALL ME HONCHO a bit slow to begin, settled inside, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and just got the show. DEE DEE'S LEGACY chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and was edged for the show. OLYMPIC STREET stalked outside a rival, split horses on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DEPUTY FLYER settled outside then off the rail, steadied off heels then split horses midway on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. OL'DOGTOWN had speed inside then took back and stalked off the rail, angled to the inside again on the turn and weakened. ORIENT EMPEROR dueled three deep between horses then outside foes, fell back on the turn and also weakened. TOM BOMBADIL broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. TOCWAY also a bit slow to begin, was sent between horses then dueled four wide and three deep leaving the backstretch, dropped back fast on the turn, gave way and was not persevered with in the stretch.
