Footnotes

EL GRAN MATADOR settled outside then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to the lead four wide in deep stretch and proved best. PREFERRED MANDATE chased outside then three deep, continued outside a rival on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, rallied between horses in deep stretch and finished well. JOHARDY dropped back off the rail on the backstretch, angled in nearing the turn and went up the fence in the stretch for the show. CHARLIE'SBOYWINS settled outside rival on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished with interest

but missed third. COAL REGION KID chased inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, split horses a sixteenth out and angled in off heels late. DOUGHBOY had good early speed and dueled inside, was bumped and headed on the turn, regained the advantage, inched clear off the rail in upper stretch, was between foes in deep stretch and weakened late. MELO LASER stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. YOU BETTOR BEWARE dueled outside a rival, put a head in front and bumped with that one midway on the turn, fought back leaving the turn and weakened in the drive. MORENO SKY settled between horses then outside a rival on the turn and lacked a response in the lane. MR. DAY TRIPPER chased between rivals, dropped back on the turn, angled in some and gave way then was eased in the stretch. REALITY RIDE between horses early, stalked inside, fell back leaving the turn, came out into the stretch, was pulled up in the drive and vanned off.
