NO KA OI chased toward the inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead past midstretch

and proved best. PINDARIC chased between horses then inside, split rivals in deep stretch and finished well for second. CATEGORIZE stalked between horses and outside a rival on the turn, continued between foes in midstretch and picked up the show. CANONITA stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter into the stretch and weakened late. NEWPORT TOPPER broke slowly, settled inside, came out off heels in midstretch and finished with some interest. MAMA LULA saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. SPORTIE'S SQUEEZE allowed to settle outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally but shared sixth. LUCERA (IRE) broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FOXY GAMES (GB) stalked three deep then outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, came out some in the stretch and weakened. STOP THE HUMOR settled outside then chased outside a rival, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. ACID (NZ) stalked outside then alongside a rival into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. BELLY BUTTON DAWN sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, fought back in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong.
