Footnotes

DOC'S ALLOWANCE duelled between horses on the backstretch and to the middle of the turn, battled off the rail leaving the bend and pulled clear in the stretch under urging. BRIEF MESSAGE angled in and forced the pace three deep to the middle of the turn, battled outside the winner leaving the bend, was not a match in the stretch but clearly second best. MYSTIC SWORD had good early speed and duelled inside on the backstretch and to the midway point on the turn, dropped back inside but held third. CANUCK chased along the inside on the backstretch and into the turn, came out leaving the bend and a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. CLASSIC CHRYS was a bit crowded at the start and slow into stride, settled inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and improved position. RASTY broke in and bumped a rival, raced close up three deep on the backstretch, was roused approaching the turn, dropped back and weakened. SIETE SLEW saved ground chasing the pace, cut the corner into the stretch and did not rally. TRADITION ROCKS bumped hard at the start, chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came between foes into the stretch and weakened. EL GIULIANI bumped and forced into a rival at the start, raced between horses early then off the rail, angled in on the turn and did not rally.
