Footnotes

TOTAL IMPACT (CHI) stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside on the second turn, gained the lead alongside a foe leaving that bend and pulled clear under urging. FLEETSTREET DANCER pulled his way along wide into the first turn, stalked outside a rival then between horses into the second turn, continued outside a foe nearing the stretch, bid toward the inside in the drive and was clearly second best. PIENSA SONANDO (CHI) allowed to lag back along the inside to the stretch, swung out in upper stretch and gained the show late. SUNDAY BREAK (JPN) four wide into the first turn, chased outside, moved up three deep with a bid on the second turn and into the stretch but could not sustain the bid in the lane and lost third late. WOODEN PHONE had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back on the second turn, had the rider lose the whip into the stretch and weakened. LETHAL INSTRUMENT saved ground in a good position chasing the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened. BRING HOME THEGOLD allowed to settle toward the inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. PALMEIRO dueled outside a rival, inched away from that one on the second turn, battled inside the winner leaving that bend and into the stretch and had little left.
