ROYAL ROBE (IRE) pulled his way between horses and steadied on the backstretch, stalked between rivals then outside a foe on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, put a head in front outside past midstretch and gamely prevailed while drifting out some under urging. FLIRT WITH FORTUNE saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the turn and three wide into the stretch and finished well. SOLITARIO stalked outside on the backstretch then bid three deep into the turn, continued outside a foe into the stretch, fought back between horses through the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. PACHARA (GB) between horses early, stalked toward the inside, split rivals leaving the turn and could not summon the needed late kick. APRIL STEEL (FR) off a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. HOT had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then between horses leaving the backstretch and into the turn, angled in leaving the bend, fought back in midstretch but weakened late. POHAVE dipped his head and walked out of the gate behind the field, settled off the inside and was not a threat. R MEADOW LUCK angled in and dueled inside on the backstretch and into the turn, dropped back on the bend and weakened.
