STREET BOSS was squeezed a bit and clipped heels just after the start, settled inside, moved up on the turn, swung out into the stretch and closed willingly under some left handed urging to prove best. SAILORS SUNSET had speed between horses then dueled outside a rival, took a short lead in the stretch and held on well but could not contain the winner late. HIGH STANDARDS also had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch and held third. EL MANUEL (CHI) settled outside a rival, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position. BONFANTE came in just after the start, stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BARBER stalked outside then four wide on the backstretch and alongside a rival on the turn, came out in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. PEACE CHANT between foes early, stalked inside, came out into the stretch and weakened some. DOPPIO chased outside a rival or off the rail, went between horses on the turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. BILO had speed between horses then stalked between foes or off the rail, continued outside a rival on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
