CAT FIGHTER stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch and four wide in midstretch, gained a short lead under urging and proved best. AMERICAN SAGA tracked the dueling leaders inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, waited briefly off heels leaving the bend, came out into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch and continued willingly to the wire. PLAYGIRL wide early, angled in and dueled outside a rival, put a head in front between horses in midstretch, could not match the top pair late but held third. MOONSTONE BAY broke slowly, trailed off the rail, swung out into the stretch and found her best stride late. NAZAREEN unhurried outside a rival then off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. ARCH ABILITY angled in and dueled inside, fought back until past midstretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. SWEET AND DEAR chased between horses then three deep early, continued off the inside on the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn and also weakened.
