Footnotes

APPLE JUICE TEA three deep into the first turn, chased a bit off the rail, ranged up outside on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and won clear under urging. ONEEXCESSIVENITE angled in and stalked the pace inside, bid outside the leader leaving the second turn, took command and inched clear into the stretch, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. LA CAMPANELLA (IRE) angled in on the first turn, moved up inside leaving the backstretch, split horses into the stretch and held third. ARTIST'S STUDIO unhurried and angled in toward the inside early, went up four wide leaving the backstretch, continued three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for the show. MYOFFICEWIFE three deep into the first turn, angled in and saved ground off the pace, came between horses into the stretch and was not a threat. BOND MIDNIGHT (IRE) pulled hard along the inside into the first turn, chased toward the rail, split horses leaving the backstretch and lacked the needed rally. GODS EAR unhurried and angled in early, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and failed to menace. DEE DEE'S DINER chased inside then between horses into the second turn, dropped back on that bend and weakened. SHE'S NO SHAM pulled her way to the early lead outside rivals, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled from the rail leaving the second turn and also weakened.
