

HAPPYANUNOIT (NZ) was off a bit slowly, went between rivals on the first turn and outside INCHACOOLEY on the backstretch, swung out a bit wide into the stretch, collared IDEALISTIC CAUSE under a couple cracks of the whip past midstretch and proved best under confident handling. IDEALISTIC CAUSE stalked the pace three deep, took a short lead in upper stretch, fought back inside the winner and went willingly to the wire. INCHACOOLEY (IRE) between rivals early, saved ground well placed, came out a bit for the stretch and just gained the show. CURITIBA saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed third. GOLDEN ARCHES (FR) took the early lead, set a pressured pace inside under a rating hold, responded into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. YOLO LADY between foes early, forced the pace outside GOLDEN ARCHES, dueled between horses leaving the second turn and into the stretch and also weakened.
