LITTLE BIT A SWISS bumped early, stalked between horses on the backstretch, bid outside the leader on the turn, took command into the stretch and drew clear under a moderate hand ride. SHESAFORTUNATECAT bobbled slightly at the start, went up three deep leaving the backstretch, was in a bit tight between horses into the turn but rallied for the place. SAINTS GAME forced out at the start, sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside the winner on the turn and into the stretch then weakened but just held third. RMISVESTA saved ground chasing the pace, came out in midstretch and split rivals at the wire. FEED THE KITTY wide between horses early and four wide into the turn, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. DOMINATED YEAR broke slowly and was squeezed, angled to the rail and saved ground off the pace, came out in upper stretch and passed a pair of tiring rivals. TRACMAC raced wide to the turn and five wide into the bend, continued outside and did not rally. KEE ALDI came out onto foes at the start, went up between rivals on the backstretch, steadied in tight into the turn and weakened. TRICKS HER hopped slightly and was bumped at the start, bore out early, was pulled up and was vanned off.
