RED DOOR DRIVE stalked the leader off the rail, bid alongside that one leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away past midstretch and held on gamely under urging. RED EYE EXPRESS (IRE) broke in and a bit slowly, settled inside, split horses early on the backstretch, continued a bit off the rail, came out and split rivals again in midstretch and finished well to just miss. WARREN'S PEPE had good early speed and set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn, fought back in the stretch and weakened some late but held third. NEVER settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed the show. TURF AND SKY pulled a bit on the first turn and chased outside a rival then along the rail on the backstretch and second turn and lacked the needed rally. BELIEVE IN HOPE saved ground off the pace, dropped back on the backstretch, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and was not a threat. GOTHIC SAMURAI (AUS) chased off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch, steadied off heels in midstretch and weakened.
