GOGI sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under urging. VICKI VICTORIA broke out and steadied a bit in a slow start, settled off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and finished well to just get the place outside foes. JESSAKAR bobbled and steadied at the start, moved up three deep into the turn, continued off the inside leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and just held third. BULLETGIRL broke in a bit, chased between horses then off the rail and was edged for the show between foes late. STRAWBERRY ROUTE stalked three deep into the turn then off the rail, angled in a bit off the fence nearing the stretch, found the inside in the drive and could not offer the necessary response. DOLPHIN BAY in tight between horses a half mile out, angled in on the turn and did not rally. MOLLY'S ALL HEART broke out a bit, stalked outside, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. GOLDEN MIRACLE a bit slow into stride, settled just off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. ALE'S EMERALD pulled with speed inside then lugged out and steadied into the turn to drop back, continued along the rail on the bend and weakened.
