

Footnotes

OUT OF MIND (BRZ) broke slowly, settled off the rail, split horses with a sharp move forward on the second turn, came out some for the stretch and rallied under some urging to collar EARLY PIONEER in deep stretch and proved best. EARLY PIONEER stalked the pace outside a rival then off the rail to the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained a short lead nearing midstretch, inched away but could not hold off the winner. SKIMMING pulled his way along inside stalking the early pace, gained the lead on the backstretch, dueled inside, fought back in midstretch, then was no match for the top pair but best of the rest. CLASSIC CAT three deep on the first turn, settled off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. DANCING AFLEET was sent to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and between horses leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. PROFOUND SECRET saved ground off the pace to the stretch, came out a bit and did not rally. PUERTO MADERO (CHI) settled between horses on the first turn then off the rail on the backstretch, came under some urging approaching the second turn, was a bit wide into the stretch and had little left.
