ESSENCE prompted the pace between horses, took a short lead into the stretch and inched away late under left handed urging. WHY KNOTT ME TOO close up stalking the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, battled outside the winner to deep stretch and held second. TINA'S LOVE sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fought back on the second turn and until just past midstretch, then could not match the top pair but bested the others. LOVE THAT HILL a bit slow to begin, stalked between horses, was shuffled from tight quarters leaving the backstretch, continued off the rail on the second turn and weakened. WILLOW RUSH chased off the rail, went up three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. POPOZINHA four wide into the first turn, bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, dropped back leaving that bend and weakened. ST. KILDA four wide into the first turn, chased off the rail, angled in some leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch, gave way and was eased late.
