**Footnotes**

PROUD OF MY CURLS stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, bid outside a rival and took the lead into the stretch and drew clear while drifting out despite right handed pressure. MY WEEKEND SQUEEZE chased off the rail, went three deep into the stretch, had the rider lose whip in midstretch but edged a rival for the place. MON QUEEN unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, split horses on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was edged for second. CLASSY CLARITA sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, angled in on the turn and weakened in the stretch. CAPTURE THE CAT stalked four wide then three deep on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the turn and also weakened. MISS APOLLITA saved ground off the pace, came out in late stretch and was not a threat. T'S ICECOLDBEER close up stalking the pace inside, weakened in the lane. PEGAKISS chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out on the turn and did not rally. DARN SWISS between foes early, angled in and saved ground off the pace and was outrun. DISCO CAT stalked three deep between foes early, dropped back into the turn, lugged out and was pulled up nearing the stretch but walked off.
