**Footnotes**

WAR PILOT chased outside a rival then inside leaving the backstretch and on the turn, bid along the rail past the eighth pole, gained the lead under urging nearing the sixteenth marker and won clear. VAUNDELL a bit slow to begin, went up between horses to duel for the lead, came out some into the stretch, was three deep past the eighth pole and held second. CAUGHT A FLYER had good early speed and dueled inside, came off the rail into the stretch, battled between horses past midstretch and just held third. SAMMARTINO saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and just missed the show. SHEDIK (FR) prompted the pace three deep, was floated out a bit into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. MARKYG settled off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch and again leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch and did not rally.
