Footnotes

LOS BOMBEBOS had good early speed and set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, inched away leaving the backstretch, kicked clear on the turn, drifted out in the stretch but held sway under urging. RED TESLA came in early, stalked outside, went four wide on the turn and three deep into the stretch, angled inward in midstretch and was second best. ITALIAN CHANNEL forced in and bumped early, chased off the rail then between horses into the turn, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. DANCING YODELER broke alertly then stalked outside, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch, split rivals in the drive and lacked the needed late kick. BEST LOGIC had speed along the rail then stalked inside, came out into the stretch, drifted back in and weakened. STORM'S END bumped and steadied between horses early, settled a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, remained inside in the stretch and did not rally. CRESTON COWBOY pulled his way between horses to press or stalk the pace and was in a bit tight nearing the half mile pole, continued just off the fence on the turn and weakened in the stretch. ENTERPRISE ZONE wide early, chased outside then three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the necessary response in the drive. HEATED PRISM broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and was

not a threat. BANK ROBBER forced in after the start, pulled between horses to press the pace then stalked outside a rival, dropped back between foes on the turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
