Footnotes

SKY JACK, wide early, ranged up four wide leaving the turn, took a short lead in midstretch, inched away under left handed urging and ducked in from the right handed whip nearing the wire. FABULOUS CONCEPT, sent between rivals to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back in the stretch but could not match the winner. FUN PARTY, steadied when crowded at the start, was sent between horses leaving the backstretch, found the rail on the turn, came out in midstretch and just held third. HUSHED VICTORY, sent between foes wide to prompt the pace, was three deep between horses on the turn and into the stretch and just missed the show. GRAYZEE GUY, off a bit slowly and taken off the rail early, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. BARDIC unhurried inside early, came off the rail on the turn, split rivals three deep into the stretch and failed to menace. ULTIMATE SHOWDOWN, four wide between foes early, prompted the pace between horses to the stretch and weakened. COWBOY BALLAD, angled in and saved ground in midpack, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. LESTERS BOY, broke inward, then angled in and saved ground forcing the pace but weakened. L. G. TITAN also saved ground off the pace and did not rally. SIR SIDDON, broke a bit slowly, raced off the rail and was outrun.
