**Footnotes**

CAUSE I'M TRICKY sent between horses early, angled in and stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, gained the lead just past the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. SHEZA GLADIATOR between horses early, stalked outside a rival, angled out into the stretch and gained the place. BLACK EYED LILLY had speed four wide then three deep on the backstretch, angled in on the lead on the turn, battled briefly outside the winner in midstretch, then was no match for that one and lost second late. MOOSSA'S GIRL sent between horses early, angled in and saved ground but lacked the needed rally. FALSTAFFS JULIETA chased outside a rival then three deep into the turn and could not offer the necessary response. GLARINGLORY off a bit slowly, settled well off the rail, went four wide on the turn and was not a factor. CONCRETE allowed to settle outside then three deep on the backstretch and turn, did not rally. FLYING FAITHFULLY sent inside to chase the leaders, remained inside on the turn, dropped back and came out into the stretch and gave way.
