SHARIYA (GER) saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside into and on the second turn, bid outside the leader into the stretch, took a short lead and pulled clear under urging. ANGEL ON TRACK sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, was no match for the winner in the stretch, drifted out and just held second. MY KIMBERLEE ANNE moved up inside to stalk the pace, continued between horses on the second turn, came out in the stretch and just missed the place. WEHO off a bit slowly, settled off the rail, moved up some leaving the second turn, swung four wide into the stretch and improved position. NEDRA bobbled at the start, went five wide into the first turn, settled outside, came four wide into the stretch and also improved position.

MIDTERM HABIT unhurried and angled in early, settled off the inside chasing the pace and was not a threat. MISS DOUBLE DOTS close up stalking the pace three deep, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. SEASONS PROMISE five wide into the first turn, chased off the rail on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. TRIBELLISTIC void of early speed a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. CAPTAIN'S SURPRISE four wide into the first turn, angled in on the backstretch and saved ground to no avail. EXY stalked the pace off he rail then outside a rival, dropped back on the second turn, drifted well wide nearing the stretch, gave way and was eased. FLYING VIXIE DUST six wide into the first turn, chased four wide on the backstretch and second turn, also dropped back on that bend and gave way.
